#### **Over 300 Global Scholars Urge SAARC Secretary-General to Intervene in the Unjust Dismissal of Dr. Snehashish Bhattacharya from South Asian University, New Delhi**

More than 300 scholars from leading universities and research institutions across the world have appealed to the Secretary-General of the South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC) to urgently intervene in the “unjust and punitive dismissal” of Dr. Snehashish Bhattacharya, Associate Professor of Economics at the South Asian University (SAU), New Delhi.

In a letter addressed to SAARC Secretary-General Ambassador Md. Golam Sarwar, the signatories — including many renowned global academics and intellectuals — have expressed deep concern over the violation of academic freedom and due process at the University, which was established under the aegis of SAARC to promote regional cooperation through higher learning. The scholars have urged the Secretary-General to call upon SAU to immediately rescind Dr. Bhattacharya’s termination, to protect academic freedom within the institution, and to uphold the founding ideals of collegiality, dialogue, and intellectual independence that underpin the University’s mandate.

Dr. Bhattacharya was terminated on September 11, 2025, with retrospective effect from June 2023 — penalizing him for having raised “principled concerns” over the administration’s handling of peaceful student protests in 2022. The students had demanded representation in gender sensitisation and anti-harassment bodies, as well as a rollback of stipend cuts. Rather than engage in constructive dialogue, as urged by faculty members, the University administration resorted to expulsions, suspensions, and police action. Later, in June 2023, four faculty members were suspended, with their pay slashed to 25 per cent without clear statutory authority. Dr. Bhattacharya’s consistent denial of all charges levelled against him, and his conscientious refusal to submit a letter of regret, was followed by his termination, which the administration justified as a response to “incitement against the University”. The signatories reject this as a distortion of his record and commitment to academic integrity.

The scholars also argue SAU’s claim that it lies outside the jurisdiction of Indian courts, even though the University was created by The South Asian University Act enacted by the Indian Parliament in 2008, undermines the rule of law and accountability. Dr. Bhattacharya has challenged this claim in Delhi High Court. [The next hearing in the Chief Justice’s Division Bench is scheduled for November 18, 2025.]

Reaffirming SAU’s original vision of fostering liberal, humane education and South Asian cooperation, the appeal warns that the recent developments have led to a climate of fear among students and staff. “Dr. Bhattacharya’s commitment to fairness and dialogue embodies the values SAU was meant to uphold,” the letter notes, adding that his dismissal threatens the very credibility of the institution as a regional centre of excellence. “This is not merely a case of one individual,” the letter concludes, “but a test of whether the South Asian University can still stand by the principles of openness, dialogue, and mutual respect on which it was founded.”

**Subject:** Appeal for urgent intervention to retract the termination of service and revoke the prior suspension of Dr. Snehashish Bhattacharya at South Asian University, New Delhi

Dear Hon'ble Ambassador Sarwar,

We, the undersigned scholars, are deeply concerned at the unjust [dismissal](#) of Dr. Snehashish Bhattacharya, Associate Professor of Economics, from service at South Asian University (SAU), New Delhi. On September 11, 2025, he was terminated with retrospective effect from June 2023, effectively punishing him for raising principled concerns about the administration's response to the 2022 student protests. As SAU functions under the aegis of SAARC, we appeal to your office, Your Excellency, for urgent intervention.

In 2022, SAU students peacefully protested for representation in the University bodies for gender sensitisation and against sexual harassment, and a rollback of reduction in their stipends. The administration responded with student expulsions, suspensions, and police action. Faculty, including Dr. Bhattacharya, urged dialogue and constructive engagement. Instead, the administration singled out Dr. Bhattacharya and three colleagues, suspended them in June 2023, and cut their pay to 25 percent without statutory basis. Dr. Bhattacharya, standing by professional [principles](#), has consistently denied all charges, and refused to submit letters of regret demanded by the university. The university has responded with his dismissal and has justified Dr. Bhattacharya's dismissal as a response to "incitement against the University". This misrepresents his good-faith commitment to teaching and student welfare.

The University has acted without transparency, fairness, or credible evidence. It has also advanced the untenable claim that, as an international institution, it lies outside Indian court jurisdiction—even though SAU was created through the [The South Asian University Act, 2008](#) of the Indian Parliament. Dr. Bhattacharya is challenging this in court, but the University's stance undermines both legality and [accountability](#). As Dr. Bhattacharya fights this, we extend our solidarity to him.

SAU was established with a vision of a world class institution emerging out of a collaborative effort in South Asia, with one of the objectives being:

"to impart liberal and humane education towards capacity building of the South Asian nations in the domain of science, technology and other areas of higher learning vital for improving their quality of life and to give students the analytical tools needed for the pursuit of profession and inculcate in them the quality of leadership."

Instead, it has seen an exodus of international faculty and repeated attempts to censor students and staff. Dr Bhattacharya's consistent good-faith actions embody the values SAU was meant to uphold. His dismissal threatens not only an individual's career but also broader principles of academic freedom, collegiality, and the University's role in nurturing future scholars and engaged citizens through openness, dialogue, and mutual respect. The gravity of the decision is reflected in the recent [letter](#) of protest signed by 101 of his former students.

Your Excellency, we urge your good offices to intervene and instruct the SAU administration to:

- Rescind its decision and reinstate Dr Bhattacharya with immediate effect.
- Ensure that procedural fairness and due process are fully observed in the resolution of this matter.
- Uphold the academic freedom and rights of faculty and students, which are essential for SAU's credibility as a SAARC institution committed to cooperation, dialogue, and regional excellence.

We submit this appeal in the spirit of collegiality and shared commitment to SAU's founding principles, trusting that your intervention may guide a fair and constructive resolution, help restore trust, protect academic freedom, and uphold the University's mission as a regional centre of excellence.
